Chase MHA Trophy Policy *Approved and Adopted 11/19/2022, modified 02/06/24*

In addition to the 3 Esso Medals of Achievement for each team, supplied by Esso Canada, beginning the 2022-2023 Season, CMHA will award trophies for the following existing Awards:

- **Goalie of the Year Award**
- **Forward of the Year Award**
- **Defenceman of the Year Award**
- **Referee of the Year Award**
- **Coach of the Year Award**
- **Jane Herman Volunteer of the Year Award**

In addition, CMHA will also create the following **NEW** awards beginning the 2022-2023 season:

- **Most Promising New Official Award**
- **Presidents Award for Outstanding service to the youth of CMHA - at Presidents discretion**

Effective the 2023-2024 season, CMHA will split all registered teams into 2 categories:

- **U9-U13 will be considered Junior**
- **U15-U18 will be considered Senior**

New Awards will then be divided accordingly as follows:

- **Junior Goalie of the Year**
- **Junior Forward of the Year**
- **Junior Defensive Player**

The existing Forward and Defensive Player of the Year will be awarded to the Senior Player of the Year in that category.

The Existing Goalie of the Year Trophy will awarded to the Senior Goalie of the Year

The following **NEW** award, open to all registered players, will recognize leadership on and off ice situations, in school, and in the community:

- **Blair Acton Community Leadership Award**

Nominations for all awards will **OPEN February 15th** of each season.

Nominations will be accepted from **ALL** CMHA Members; Coaches, Managers, Parents (including Legal Guardians) and Executives.

Nominations will **CLOSE March 15th**.

The Executive, Board including all elected and appointed positions, will review the nominees and select three finalists. They will then vote on the final award winners.

The three finalists will be recognized at the Annual Awards Banquet and the winners will be recognized and awarded at the Year End event. All winners will receive a keeper plaque or small trophy.

CMHA retains ownership and custody of "Big Trophies" which will be kept in the arena Trophy case
In Addition, CMHA will create/ re name its tournament Trophies to reflect the new "U- designation"
to replace old division names
